

## The Basket process is 7 steps in all- This will give you an idea of the process-made with much aloha!



### Manila Palm

1 of several palms I use. The green sheath (seen at the base of the leaf) is folded inside out to make my baskets



**1. Where Each Basket Begins**  
The gathering of materials. Palm Fronds & other decorative elements are collected regularly



**2. Soak, Cut, and Sew**  
I moisten the frond to be able to fold it inside out, then I cut and sew them



**5. Adorning**  
I embellish the basket by adding unique combinations of natural elements



### 3. Collaring

I cut and stitch on the Coconut fiber collar

### 4. Roping

I sew on the Norfolk Island pine branches as an added detail



### 6. Preserving

I apply a finish to preserve and enrich the colors

### 7. Tagging

Individual tags identify the plant components used for that particular basket.
